

**All coaches *in WNY* may send to anyone who may be concerned that their boys cannot afford our program:**

**BOTRT of WNY Accessibility Program 2024**

All of us at Boys on the Right Track pride ourselves in working hard to never turn a participant away due to financial limitations. If our program is NOT covered by your insurance (please contact us with your insurance information to discuss eligibility) we are pleased to offer several options to those in need of financial assistance. PLEASE NOTE FINANCIAL AID IS NEED BASED AND LIMITED.

Option 1: This option allows families to break their registration fee into two or three payments making the fee more manageable.

Option 2: This option provides a sliding scale registration fee utilizing the federal income eligibility guidelines from the USDA Food and Nutrition program.

Option 3: In the event that a participant is unable to pay the amount determined to be fair under the federal income eligibility guidelines, even after breaking the cost down into 3 payments, they are to be directed to Juliet Meade who will send them a fundraising link. They will be required to secure at least 50% of the total amount determined to be fair under the Federal guidelines through donations (with a minimum of \$55- this cost reflects the inclusion of the buddy runner fee) prior to being registered for the season and BOTRT will match the remaining 50% through funding.

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Option 3: In the event that a participant is unable to pay the amount determined to be fair under the federal income eligibility guidelines, even after breaking the cost down into 3 payments, they are to be directed to Juliet Meade who will send them a fundraising link. They will be required to secure at least 50% of the total amount determined to be fair under the Federal guidelines through donations (with a minimum of \$40) prior to being registered for the season and BOTRT will match the remaining 50% through funding.
